**H**IS Honor the Superintendent directs the following notification to be published for general information:—

**I**, JAMES EDWARD FITZ GERALD, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in virtue of the powers vested in me by the 43rd clause of the Waste Lands' Regulations now in force within the said Province, do hereby reserve from sale until the days undermentioned respectively, the portions of land hereinafter described, that is to say,—

Twenty-three acres situate in Pigeon Bay, Banks' Peninsula, bounded on the north by the road bounding the south boundary of rural section 441, and on the west by the Akaroa and Pigeon-bay Road, subject to a road, if required, up the valley south-easterly, to be reserved until the 28th day of November next.

The whole of such land, or such part thereof as the Waste Lands' Board shall adjudge, to be granted to William

Crouch, by way of payment for work done in accordance with a contract this day approved by me for the construction of a portion of the road from Robinson's-bay, Akaroa, to Okain's Bay.

Twenty-two acres, situate in Laverick's-bay, Banks' Peninsula, fronting on the sea beach, bounded on the west by a line at right angles to the beach, from the point where the creek runs into the sea, to be reserved until the 28th day of November next.

The whole of such land or such part thereof as the Waste Lands' Board shall adjudge, to be granted to William Webb, by way of payment for work done in accordance with a contract this day approved by me for the construction of a portion of the road from Robinson's Bay, Akaroa, to Okain's Bay.

Twenty Acres, situate at Akaroa, Banks' Peninsula, south of the road on the southern boundary line of Section 332, in Duvau-chelle's Bay, fronting the road or beach Reserve five chains, subject to pre-emptive right No. 334, to be reserved until the 15th day of June instant.

The whole of such land, or such portion thereof as the Waste Lands' Board shall adjudge, to be granted to Jacob Waeckerle, by way of payment for work done in accordance with a contract this day approved by me for the construction of bridges in Akaroa.

Five acres, more or less, situate near Riccarton, in the Christchurch District, situate on a small stream or water-course, about one quarter of a mile South of the road leading from the

Harewood road by Riccarton towards "Prebble's" and the "Springs" runs, on the south-western boundary of rural section No. 275, and numbered 106 in red on the Chief Surveyor's map of the Christchurch District.

Five acres, more or less, situate in the Christchurch District, about half a mile from the River Avon, at the south-eastern corner of rural section No. 273, being in the vicinity of a water-hole at the edge of the Sand-hills, and numbered 107 in red, on the Chief Surveyor's said map.
