I, JAMES EDWARD FITZ GERALD, Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in virtue of the powers vested in me by the 43rd clause of the Waste Lands' Regulations now in force within the said Province, do hereby reserve from sale until the sixth day of February next, the portions of land hereinafter described, that is to say,—

Twenty acres, situate in Okain's Bay, Banks' Peninsula, bounded on the south-east in part by rural section 343, and on the north-east in part by the school reserve; the section to be as nearly square as the regulations will permit.

The whole of such land, or such part thereof as the Waste Lands' Board shall adjudge, to be granted to William Gilbert, by way of payment for work done in accordance with a contract this day approved by me for the construction of a portion of the Okain's Bay Road.

Twenty acres, situate in Okain's Bay, Banks' Peninsula, fronting on the road running along the south-east side of rural section 343, bounded on the south by Mr. Thacker's section, and with as large frontage as the regulations will allow.

*Conditions:—*To provide stable accommodation for eight horses, and to have corn always on hand. To provide suitable accommodation for travellers. To keep stockyards in sufficient repair. To provide such postal facilities as the Provincial Government may require.

Henry Yates Miller..... Saltwater Creek.

*Conditions:—*To provide three bedrooms and six beds. To provide a stock-yard and sheep-yard. To keep a ferry-boat for foot passengers, and ferry them over the Saltwater Creek, between the hours of 8 a. m. and 6 p. m., at one penny each, and double fares at all other times.

John Pawson... Head of Akaroa Harbour.

*Conditions:—*Ferry boat to be kept in good working order, and ready for conveyance of passengers between the town of Akaroa and the head of the harbour, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. from October to March, and between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. from April to September. The charge for passage to be five shillings for one passenger, or two shillings and sixpence per head if more than one. License to be cancelled in case of drunkenness or disorderly conduct, or of supplying spirits to Natives.
