HIS HONOR THE SUPERINTENDENT directs the publication of the following Notice.

The Provincial Government are prepared to receive tenders for leasing the block of land reserved for the landing of diseased sheep on Adderly Heads, containing 2530 acres or thereabouts on the following terms.

The lease to be for a term of not more than three years, from the 1st February 1857.

No sheep to be placed on the run by the Lessee;—only cattle or horses.

In case any diseased sheep shall be ordered to be landed on the run, the Lessee to remove his stock therefrom immediately on receiving notice from an Inspector of sheep that the run is required by the Government for diseased sheep.

The rent for each year to be paid in advance—to be repaid by the Government for the time the Lessee may be deprived of the occupation of the run for the above purpose.

Applications to be made in writing to the Provincial Secretary before Monday the 31st instant, stating the amount of rent offered, and the term of lease required.

The Government will not be bound to accept the highest tender.
