I, CHARLES BOWEN, the Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Canterbury, in virtue of the powers vested in me by the 43rd clause of the Waste Lands' Regulations, now in force within the said Province, do hereby reserve from sale the portion of land hereinafter described, that is to say—

Twenty-seven acres situate in Charteris Bay, to the Eastward of and adjoining Section 265, subject to a road in continuation of the road from the head of the bay, through Mr. Moore's land, and subject to Pre-emptive right No. 265.
