HIS Honor the Superintendent directs it to be notified that he has made the following Reserves temporarily under the 19th clause of the Waste Lands Regulations, viz:—

No. 1676 (in red).—Ten acres, more or less, situate in McQueen's Flat; bounded on the north-westward by the Little River Road; on the north-eastward by section 12130; on the south-eastward by a line parallel to the north-western boundary and ten chains distant therefrom; and on the

south-westward by a line at right angles to the last described boundary, so as to contain the above quantity.—For Provincial Government purposes.

No. 1677 (in red).—Five acres, more or less, situate at the centre point of the Big Bay, near Kaituna; bounded on the westward by the road reserved along the high water line of Lake Ellesmere, and also by the Little River Road; on the southward by the first mentioned road; on the northward by the road forming the south-western boundary of section 9250, and a line in continuation of the southern side of that road; and on the eastward by a line at right angles to the northern boundary, so as to include the above quantity.—For metal reserve.

No. 1678 (in red).—Ten acres, more or less, situate at Kaituna Point; bounded on the north-westward by the road reserved along the high water line of Lake Ellesmere; on the southward and south-eastward by the Little River Road; and on the north-eastward by a straight line at right angles to the general direction of the south-eastern boundary, so as to contain the above quantity.—For metal reserve.
