THE following regulations for the conduct of Sports and Races within the Christchurch Race Course having been issued pursuant to "The Race Course Reserve Ordinance, Session XI, No. 7," and approved of by His Honor the Superintendent, are published for general information:

1. The sums of money following shall be payable and paid to the President of the Canterbury Jockey Club for the admission of persons, animals, and vehicles to the said Race Course on the 10th, 11th and 13th days of November, 1874, that is to say:

For each horseman	2s. 6d.
" vehicle drawn by one horse	5s.
" " " two horses	10s.
" " " three or more	20s.
" foot passenger	1s.

And no person, animal, or vehicle shall be permitted to enter upon the said Race Course without prepayment to the said President or some person to be appointed by him for that purpose, of such sum or sums of money as aforesaid.

2. No horseman will be allowed to gallop on any part of the said course.

3. All persons refusing to conform to these regulations or any of them shall be forthwith removed from the said Race Course.
