PROCLAMATION.

BY THOMAS HENRY FITZGERALD  
 Esq., Superintendent of the Pro-  
 vince of Hawke's Bay.

WHEREAS by an Act of the  
 General Assembly of New Zea-  
 land, Session 4, No. 16, intituled "The  
 Superintendent's Deputy Act of 1856,"  
 the Superintendent of any Province is  
 empowered by Proclamation in the  
*Provincial Government Gazette* to ap-  
 point such registered elector of the Pro-  
 vince as he may think fit to be his De-  
 puty,—and as such to perform and ex-  
 ercise all the Acts and powers (except  
 such powers as are conferred by the  
 Constitution Act) which may be exer-

eised and performed by such Superin-  
 tendent, or such of them only as shall  
 be specified in such proclamation,—  
 NOW THEREFORE, I, THOMAS  
 HENRY FITZGERALD, Superintendent  
 of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do  
 hereby in virtue of the power conferred  
 on me by the aforesaid Act, proclaim  
 that I have this day appointed

CAPTAIN J. C. L. CARTER,  
 to be Deputy Superintendent of this  
 Province under the provisions of the  
 above recited Act.
