BOUNDARIES

Commencing at the lake called Oreore, and following the Eastern branch to the end; from thence to a point on the shoulder of the hill called Ngamahanga; which line bears by compass $356^{\circ} 36'$ from thence to a point at the foot of a ridge of hills near the bank of the Tutaekuri river, and thence to the Tutaekuri. The boundary then follows the course of the Tutaekuri upwards, to the mouth of a creek which rises near the head of Mangatarata, and up said creek to a point near its source; it then strikes across to the Mangatarata, and down that stream to its junction with the Okawa river, and down the Okawa to the Oreore lake.
