Unless the Government are likely soon to acquire more land, I feel it imperative on me to advise that the Survey Staff be reduced to three Surveyors and one Draughtsman, and, indeed, if the system is continued of allowing accredited private Surveyors to execute surveys in terms of Section IV, Clause XV, of Land Regulations, March 4th, 1853, two Surveyors would be sufficient.

After the end of this quarter the office work in this Department could be performed by one Draughtsman, as already there are 953 Crown Grants prepared, and several of the maps required for the Registration Office are completed.
