WARRANT

DELEGATING TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF
 HAWKE'S BAY THE GOVERNOR'S POWER
 TO APPOINT RETURNING OFFICERS &c.

By His Excellency Colonel Thomas
 Gore Browne, Companion of
 the most honorable order of the
 Bath, Governor and Comman-
 der-in-Chief in and over Her
 Majesty's Colony of New Zea-
 land and its Dependencies, and
 Vice-Admiral of the same, &c.

WHEREAS by the "Provincial
 Elections Act, 1858," the Go-
 vernor is empowered to delegate to the
 Superintendent of any Province the
 power of appointing and removing Re-

turning Officers and also of appointing
 and establishing Polling Places for the
 election of the Superintendent or of
 members of the Provincial Council of
 such Province. **NOW, THERE-**
FORE, I, Thomas Gore Browne, the
 Governor of the said Colony of New
 Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of
 the said power and authority, do hereby
 delegate to John Chilton Lambton
 Carter, Esquire, the Superintendent
 of the Province of Hawke's Bay in the
 said Colony the above recited powers,
TO BE HELD and exercised by him
 from time to time as he shall think fit
 so long as he shall hold the said office
 of Superintendent.

GENERAL AUTHORITY
TO INSTITUTE PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE
"ARMS ACT, 1860."

By His Excellency Colonel Thomas Gore Browne, Companion of the most honorable order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c.

IN pursuance of the power vested in me under the "Arms Act, 1860," I, Thomas Gore Browne, the Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, do hereby appoint Charles William Renell La Serre, Chief Officer of the Police in the Province of Hawke's Bay, to be a person by whom, and at whose instance, Indictments and Informations shall be preferred or proceedings instituted against any person for any offence by the said Act declared to be a felony or misdemeanor.
