*In the matter of the Petition of ROBERT RIDDELL, of Te Huata, Wairoa, in the Province of Hawke's Bay, Storekeeper and Farmer.*

On the tenth day of October, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five.

UPON reading the Petition and the several affidavits filed herein and upon hearing Mr. Izard of Counsel for the said Petitioner Robert Riddell it is ordered that the Estate of the said Robert Riddell be sequestrated into the hands of James Grindell Esquire the Deputy Registrar of the Supreme Court at Napier until the hearing of the said Petition or until the further order of the Court herein And it is further ordered that a meeting of the Creditors of the said Robert Riddell be held at

Mr. Wilson's office at Napier on TUESDAY the fourteenth day of November next at the hour of twelve o'clock at noon for the purpose of recommending Trustees to the Court and the mode of winding up the said Estate And it is further ordered that the said Petition be heard at the Supreme Court House Napier on the 31st day of January next at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon and that protection of the person and estate of the said Robert Riddell be granted until the hearing of the said Petition or until the further order of the Court herein And it is further ordered that the said Robert Riddell be forthwith discharged from the custody of the Gaoler at Napier at the suit of S. F. Prentice & Co. or any other detaining creditor provided always that such protection shall be of no force or effect should any Creditor of the said Robert Riddell be in a position to issue a Writ of Arrest against the said Robert Riddell in accordance with the Writ of Arrest Act to the satisfaction of a Judge or Registrar of the said Court in the absence of such Judge.

gistrar of the Supreme Court at Napier until the hearing of the said Petition or until the further order of the Court herein And it is further ordered that the said Petition be heard at the Supreme Court House Napier on the 31st day of January next and that protection of the person and estate of the said Alexander Stewart Aikin be granted until the hearing of the said Petition or until the further order of this Court And it is further ordered that the said Alexander Stewart Aikin be forthwith discharged from the custody of the Gaoler at Napier at the suit of Louis Butcher or any other detaining creditor Provided always that such protection shall be of no force or effect should any creditor of the said Alexander Stewart Aikin be in a position to issue a Writ of Arrest against the said Alexander Stewart Aikin in accordance with the Writ of Arrest Act to the satisfaction of a Judge or Registrar of the said Court in the absence of such Judge.
