PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor JOSEPH RHODES, Esq.,
Deputy-Superintendent of the
Province of Hawke's Bay, in the
Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intitled "The Provincial Reserve Bills Act 1858," it is provided that no Bill reserved for the signification of the Governor's pleasure shall have any force within the Province until the Superintendent shall signify, as therein specified, that it has been laid before the Governor, and that His Excellency has assented to the same; and whereas certain Acts intitled

"The Volunteer and Militia Remission Certificate Act 1868,"

"The Appropriation Act 1868,"

"The Hawke's Bay Loan Appropriation Act Amendment Act 1868,"

"The Educational Rates Act 1868,"

"The Credit Act 1868,"

were passed by the Provincial Council of Hawke's Bay during the last session, but reserved by me for the signification of the Governor's pleasure; now, therefore, I, JOSEPH RHODES, do hereby proclaim and notify that the abovementioned Acts have been duly laid before His Excellency the Governor, and, having received his assent, are, under the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly before referred to, in

force within the Province of Hawke's Bay from the date of this Proclamation.

PROCLAMATION.

By DONALD McLEAN, Esquire, Superintendent of the province of Hawke's Bay, in the colony of New Zealand.

I, DONALD McLEAN, Superintendent as aforesaid, by virtue of all powers in this behalf in anywise enabling me as Deputy of His Excellency the Governor of the colony of New Zealand, do hereby call out for the purpose of training—

- 1st. All the men of the first and second class of the Napier Regiment of Militia, known as Nos. 1 and 2, Napier Town.
- 2nd. All the men known as the Napier Volunteers, Capt. Buchanan's Company.
- 3rd. All the men of the first and second class of the Napier Regiment of Militia, known as Company No. 4, Napier Country District.
- 4th. All the men of the first and second class of the Napier Regiment of Militia, known as Company No. 3, Clive and Havelock; also, all the men of the first and second class of Companies Nos. 5, 6, 7, 10 and 11.

And I hereby authorise and request Lieutenant-Colonel George Stoddart Whitmore, the Officer commanding Militia and Volunteers in Hawke's Bay, to carry into effect this direction.

I, DONALD McLEAN, Superintendent of the Province of Hawke's Bay, do hereby proclaim that a sale of Crown lands will take place at the Crown Lands Office, Napier, on TUESDAY, September 29, 1868, at noon precisely, when the allotments of land specified in the schedule hereunto annexed, except such as may be reserved under the provision hereinafter mentioned, and which have been duly certified by the Commissioner of Crown Lands on the application of intending purchasers, as being unavailable for agricultural purposes, will be put up to Public Auction at the upset price of 5s. an acre, in accordance with the Land Regulations of the 4th March, 1853, and the additional regulations for the amendment and extension of the said Regulations recommended by the Superintendent and the Council for the Province of Wellington (Session 2) to the Governor.
