IN PURSUANCE and in exercise of the power and authority in me vested by virtue of a warrant under the hand of His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, appointing me, Donald McLean, to be the Deputy of His Excellency the Governor for the purpose of directing the Officer Commanding the Napier Militia District, to draw out for actual service the whole or any part of the men of the Militia in the said district pursuant to the "Militia Act 1858," I, Donald McLean, do hereby order and direct you, Edward Withers, Captain, the Officer commanding the Militia in the Napier Militia District, with all convenient speed to draw out for actual service all such portion of the men of the Militia in the said district of the

third class as is hereinafter mentioned, viz:—The men belonging to No. 8, or the Reserve Company, in Napier, Puketapu, Meance, Petane, Clive, and Havelock.
