ELECTION OF AUDITORS UNDER THE
NELSON TRUST FUNDS ACT.

WHEREAS a WRIT, under the hand of His Honour JOHN PERRY ROBINSON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, bearing date the Thirteenth day of December instant, has been directed to me, John Poynter, Esquire, Resident Magistrate and Returning Officer for the Province of Nelson, requiring and commanding me to cause to be elected by and from amongst the voters duly qualified for that purpose, freely and indifferently and in manner and form by law prescribed, TWO PERSONS to serve as AUDITORS under the Nelson Trust Funds Act:
