PROCLAMATION.

By his Honour JOHN PERRY ROBINSON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by an Act passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Nelson, in Session III., No. 4, intituled "The Country Roads Act, 1856," it was amongst other things enacted, that it should be lawful for the Superintendent, from time to time, to constitute and appoint certain districts in which the said Act should come into operation, and the limits of such districts from time to time to alter, as occasion might require; and also, if he should see fit, to revoke the Proclamation by which such districts should have been constituted, and to make such other provisions as he should think necessary for carrying into effect the said Act: And whereas, by a Proclamation of his Honour the Superintendent of the said Province, bearing date the ninth day of April, 1856, the said in part recited Act was proclaimed, constituted, and appointed to come into operation in certain districts therein specified: And whereas it is expedient that the said Proclamation should be revoked, and other provisions made in lieu thereof: Now therefore, I, the Superin-

tendent of the Province of Nelson, hereby revoke the aforesaid Proclamation, and I do hereby proclaim, constitute, and appoint the following districts in which the said in part recited Act shall come into operation; that is to say—

SUBURBAN-NORTH DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by a line known as the Native Boundary Line, commencing at highwater mark at the northern angle of section numbered 36, and running in a southeasterly direction for a distance of five and a-half miles;

Eastward, by a line running from the last-named point six miles, in the direction of the mud-hut, situated on section number 36 in the Motupiko Valley;

Southward, by the boundary line between sections numbered 3 and 4, and continuing westerly to the Boulder Bank and easterly to the eastern boundary aforesaid;

Westward, by the sea.

SUBURBAN-SOUTH DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by the northern boundary line of section No. 12, Suburban-south, continued in a straight line westward to high-

water mark, and eastward to the eastern boundary of the district;

Eastward, by a line in the same direction as the eastern boundary line of Suburban-north district, commencing three and a-half miles from the southern boundary of the last-named district, and running four and a-half miles;

Southward, by the boundary line between sections numbered 97 and 98, Waimea-east, continued in a straight line westward to highwater mark, and eastward to the eastern boundary aforesaid;

Westward, by the sea.

#### WAIMEA-EAST DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, partly by highwater mark from section numbered 207 to section numbered 77, and partly by the southern boundary of Suburban-south district;

Eastward, by a line in continuation of the eastern boundary of Suburban-south district for a distance of six miles;

Southward, by a line at right angles to the eastern boundary, until it strikes the banks of the river Wairoa, and thence along the river Wairoa to its junction with the river Waimea;

Westward, by the river Waimea.

#### WAIMEA SOUTH DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, partly by a line drawn from the south-west angle of Section numbered 189, Moutere, to the banks of the river Wai-iti at Forty-line, partly by the eastern bank of the Wai-iti river to its junction with the river Wairoa, partly by the southern bank of the river Wairoa, and partly by the southern boundary of the Waimea East district;

Eastward, by a line in continuation of the eastern boundary of the Waimea East district for a distance of thirteen miles;

Southward, by a line at right angles to the eastern boundary for a distance of six miles;

Westward, by a line running from the termination of the last-mentioned boundary to Section No. 189, in the district of the Moutere.

#### WAIMEA WEST DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by highwater mark at Section 25, Waimea West, to Section No. 2, in the same district;

Eastward, partly by the river Waimea, and partly by the river Wai-iti;

Southward, by the boundary line of Waimea South district, from the banks of the Wai-iti to the south-west angle of Section numbered 189, Moutere;

Westward, by a line from the south-west angle of Section No. 189, Moutere, to the north-west angle of Section No. 25, Waimea West.

#### MOUTERE DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, partly by the river Motueka, from Section numbered 60 to Section numbered 258, Motueka, and partly by a line from section-peg 258, on the banks of the Motueka river, running eastward to the north-east angle of Section numbered 172, Motueka;

Eastward, by highwater mark from Section No. 172, Motueka, to Section No. 25, Waimea West;

Southward, by a line from the north-west angle of Section No. 25, Waimea West, to the south-west angle of Section No. 189, Moutere;

Westward, by a line running from the south-west angle of Section No. 189, to the south-east angle of Section No. 22, Moutere, and thence to the south-west angle of Section No. 60, Motueka, continuing on the western boundary of Section No. 60, to the Motueka river.

#### MOTUEKA DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, and Westward, by the Motueka river;

Eastward, by highwater mark from the mouth of the river Motueka to Section numbered 172, Motueka;

Southward, by a line running from highwater mark at Section numbered 172 to Section No. 258, on the banks of the Motueka river.

#### RIWAKA DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by a line from the north-east angle of Section No. 28, Motueka, to the south-west angle of Section No. 96, Motueka;

Eastward, by highwater mark;

Southward, by the banks of the Motueka river to the north-west angle of Section No. 60;

Westward, by a line from the north-west angle of Section No. 60 to Section No. 28, Motueka.

## MOTUPIPI DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by a line along highwater mark, from the end of the road through Section No. 77 to the north-east corner of Section No. 151;

Eastward, by a line from the last-named point to the south-east corner of Section No. 153, and thence to the Takaka river at the south-east corner of Section No. 184;

Southward, by a line from the last-named point to the south-east angle of Section No. 148, and thence by a line due west for two miles;

Westward, by a line running due north for nine and a half miles, from the termination of the southward boundary to the south-west corner of Section No. 74, and thence by a straight line to the commencement of the northern boundary.

## WAIRAU DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by the Wairau river from the confluence of the Branch river to the sea;

Eastward, from the mouth of the last-named river along the sea-coast to the southern extremity of the Boulder Bank;

Southward, by a straight line from the last-mentioned point to the south-west corner of Section No. 9, Block II., Waihopai;

Westward, by a straight line from the last-named point to the aforesaid confluence of the Branch and Wairau rivers.

## AWATERE DISTRICT.

*Bounded as follows:*

Northward, by the southern boundary of the Wairau district;

Eastward, by the sea from the southern extremity of the Boulder Bank to the mouth of the Flags river;

Southward and Westward by a straight line from the mouth of the said river to the south-west corner of Section No. 9, Block II., Waihopai.
