PROCLAMATION.

By his Excellency Colonel THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor of the Colony of New Zealand, &c., &c.

WHEREAS, by an Ordinance enacted by the Governor of New Zealand, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, Session III., No. 1, intituled "An Ordinance for establishing a Supreme Court," the Governor of New Zealand is empowered, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation from time to time to divide the Colony into Districts for the purposes of the said recited Ordinance, and the limits of such Districts from time to time to alter, as occasion may require:

And whereas the said Colony is now divided into two Districts, called respectively the Northern District and the Southern District:

And whereas, by the said recited Ordinance, the Governor is also empowered to assign to each of such Districts a Judge or Judges who shall have within the same all the powers and jurisdiction thereby given to the Supreme Court:

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in pursuance of such authority, do hereby proclaim and declare that I have assigned to the Southern District

SIDNEY STEPHEN, Esquire,
Chief Justice of the said Court, to have and exercise therein the said powers and jurisdiction on and after the first of April now ensuing,

until the tenth day of May next, in the place and stead of

DANIEL WAKEFIELD, Esquire,
a judge of the said Court, who is incapacitated by illness from performing the duties of his office.
