ALTERATION OF ROADS.

NOTICE is hereby given, that APPLICATION is intended to be made to the Provincial Council of Nelson, at its next session, to pass an Ordinance authorizing the Alteration of Roads specified below; the application for an order for such alteration made by the undersigned, on the 7th day of May last, to the Justices of the Peace at Richmond, having failed, in consequence of one-sixth of the parties affected thereby having objected thereto.

To stop up parts of a certain road in Waimea East, commencing at the cross roads at the W. corner of Section 59, and going S.E. 20½ chains, between Sections 58 and 59; thence 38 chains S. through Section 2 of 1, and there terminating; excepting a small portion of the first-named part, where the proposed road will intersect the said road.

And to substitute a road, 50 links wide, commencing on the E. side of the public road, passing along the W. side of Section 59, at 9½ chains from the W. corner of the said Section, and proceeding 7 chains S.E., and 45 chains S., through Sections 59 and 2 of 1, to the ridge of the hills; thence 20 chains S.S.E., and 13 chains E., through Sections 2 of 1, and III., and ending at the termination of the road proposed to be stopped up.
