APPLICATIONS for DEPASTURAGE LICENSES, in Accordance with the Regulations under the Waste Lands Act, 1858, received by the Commissioner of Crown Lands during the Months of **SEPTEMBER, OCTOBER, and NOVEMBER, 1862.**

JOHN ROCHFORD—District, the Inangahua.

For all the open land situated on the Inangahua or Thackery and Waitu Rivers. Bounded on the northward and eastward by bush; on the southward and westward, by the Inangahua River.

F. L. VICKERMAN—District, the Waiau-ua.

Bounded on the north by a line running easterly from the junction of the River Ada with the Waiau-ua to the summit of the

range dividing the Waiau and Clarence Valleys, being part of southern boundary line in Mr. Travers' amended application; on the eastward, by a line running southerly along the range from the point where the northern boundary strikes the range, dividing the Waiau and Clarence Valleys, to a point on the northern boundary of Edwards' larger run; on the south, by a line running in a south-westerly direction to the Waiau River, being portion of the northern boundary of Edwards' larger run, thence by the River Waiau to a stream marked on the plan of Edwards' larger run as leading to the River Boyle, thence by such stream till it strikes the northern boundary of Edwards' smaller run, thence by the northern boundary of Edwards' smaller run to its north-west angle, and thence by a line running in a westerly direction

to the saddle dividing the sources of the Rivers Ann and Boyle; on the west and north-west, by the Rivers Ann and Henry to where the latter runs into the Waiau-ua, and thence by the Waiau to the junction of the River Ada with it,
