PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor ALFRED SAUNDERS, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Islands of New Zealand, &c., &c., &c.

**WHEREAS** by an Act passed by the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Nelson, in Session XIII., No. 1, intituled, "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSPECTION OF CARRIAGES USED FOR THE CONVEYANCE OF PASSENGERS FOR HIRE," it is enacted that the said Act shall come into operation in such Districts as the Superintendent shall from time to time proclaim for that purpose, by proclamation in the *Government Gazette* of the Province, from and after a day to be fixed in such proclamation: Now, therefore, I, the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, do hereby proclaim and declare that the said recited Act shall come into operation in the City of Nelson, as defined by the "Electoral Districts Act," passed by the Provincial Council of Nelson, in Session

XIII., number 3, from and after the Second day of October next.
