ANNUAL REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES OF  
THE NELSON TRUST FUNDS, FOR THE  
YEAR ENDED 1st DECEMBER, 1867.

THE closing paragraph of the Report accompanying the accounts of the Trust Funds for the year ended the 1st December, 1866,

was to the effect that the claim made by the Trustees upon the Underwriters, on account of the steamer "Nelson," was at that time unsettled. A final settlement has now been made. The amount for which insurance had been effected, in England, up to the date of the steamer's stranding at the Grey, was £5600. The amount recovered under these policies after the usual deductions was £5165 9s. 8d., as shewn in the present accounts. The amount of loss on account of the "Nelson," inclusive of the proportions of the previous claims disallowed, appears as £4558 17s., leaving a small balance due from some outstanding accounts in Nelson, which will appear next year.

As a considerable portion of the "Religious Reserve Fund" had been appropriated

for the use of the Steam Fund in connection with the account of the steamer "Nelson," the Trustees have now made the Steam Fund chargeable with the interest accruing on such amount of advance for the period during which it was so appropriated. A portion of the Reserve Fund was also so advanced; but as that Fund may be appropriated to such purposes as the Trustees may think desirable; and as, moreover, the

advance was simply out of interest accruing on the outstanding loans, a charge of interest against the Steam Fund, as in the case of the advance from the Religious Reserve Fund, is quite unnecessary.
