PROTECTION is hereby granted for Six Months from 1st April, instant, under the provisions of "The Goldfields Act, 1866," to HENRY EARLES, for the right of FERRYING across FOX'S RIVER, for a distance of half-a-mile from the mouth of the river, and he is authorised to charge from 1st April, to 30th September, 1869, fares, as per Schedule, on the following conditions:—

1. That a good safe Boat and competent Ferryman shall be at all times in attendance.
2. That Government Officers on duty be ferried free of charge.
3. That this Protection shall not be transferred without the authority of the Warden of the district.
4. That this Protection shall not affect the right of the Government to erect or grant Protection for any bridge within the protected limits.
