THE SUPERINTENDENT directs it to be notified for general information, that the Justices' Order dated 27th day of April, 1869, granting the Alteration of certain Roads in the City of Nelson, as described in the application of JOHN SHARP, JOSEPH AUTY HARLEY, and JAMES KING, published in the *Nelson Government Gazette*, No. 14, of the 19th day of March, 1869, has been confirmed by the Superintendent and Executive Council.

JAMES F. JOHNSTON is hereby authorised, under Section XIII. of the "Goldfields Act 1866," to Construct a Track commencing at Little Grey, and ending at Maori Gully; and protected in the occupation thereof, for the period of three months from the 5th day of March last, upon the following conditions:—

1. That the Track shall at all times be maintained in a good state of repair, and no Tolls be recoverable unless the Warden be satisfied that this condition has been fully complied with.

2. That any person using the Track may at any time become a part proprietor, on payment of a proportionate share of the expenditure on such Track, the amount so payable to be settled by arbitration, in the usual way.
3. That this protection does not interfere with any existing rights or privileges, nor prejudice the right of the Government to make or grant protection to any other Track; but no protection will be granted for any other Track within a chain of this one.
4. That all Government Officers, Road Overseers and Laborers, and Postmen shall use the Track, when on duty, free of charge.
5. That this protection shall not be transferred without the sanction of the Warden of the district.
6. That the Track shall, if required, be given up to the Government, at any time, at a valuation.
7. That the Tolls to be charged for using the said Track shall not exceed the following:—

ALEXANDER M'DONALD and JOHN HAMIL are hereby authorised, under Section XIII. of the "Goldfields Act 1866," to Construct a Track, commencing at Thorogood's House, on the Amuri Road, passing through Orwell Creek, and terminating at Jocke's Bakery on Napoleon Hill; and protected in the occupation thereof for a period of one year from the 1st day of May instant, upon the following conditions, viz. :—

1. That the Track shall at all times be maintained in a good state of repair, and no Tolls be recoverable unless the Warden be satisfied that this condition has been fully complied with.
2. That any person using the Track may at any time become a part proprietor on payment of a proportionate share of the expenditure on such Track, the amount so payable to be settled by arbitration in the usual way.

3. That this protection does not interfere with any existing rights or privileges, nor prejudice the right of the Government to make or grant protection to any other Track; but no protection will be granted for any other Track within a chain of this one.
4. That all Government Officers, Road Overseers and Laborers, and Postmen shall use the Track, when on duty, free of charge.
5. That this protection shall not be transferred without the sanction of the Warden of the district.
6. That the Track shall, if required, be given up to the Government, at any time, at a valuation.
