PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor OSWALD CURTIS, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Islands of New Zealand, &c., &c., &c.

IN exercise of the power and authority, enabling me in that behalf, I, OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, do hereby withdraw all that Parcel of Land hereinafter described, situate within the boundaries of the Nelson South-west Goldfields, from the operation of the Goldfields Act, and declare the same open for sale from and after the date hereof, that is to say:—
