PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Islands of New Zealand.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers in me vested and enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby proclaim and declare that, from and after the First day of February next, all that District of the Province of Marlborough lying between the Clarence river, the Conway river, the Seaward Kaikoura range, and the Sea, shall be deemed to be an INFECTED DISTRICT within the meaning of "The Diseased Cattle Act, 1861," and that no Cattle shall be allowed to be imported from that District into the Province of Nelson.

Given under my hand, and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of Nelson, this Tenth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-one.

THE House of Representatives having resolved that there should be an Exhibition in Wellington during the next Session of the Assembly, of all varieties of Flax Fibre prepared in the Colony, *Manufacturers* are invited to forward to the Flax Commissioners, through the Superintendent of their Province, samples of the Fibre, Rope, Sacking, or other material, prepared by them from the New Zealand Flax.

The samples of Fibre should not be less than 20lbs. in weight, and ten or fifteen fathoms of each kind of Rope will be sufficient. It is desirable that a statement of the process and estimated cost of manufacture should accompany the samples.
