PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Islands of New Zealand, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS, by "The Protection of Animals Act, 1867," it is provided that no Game shall be Hunted, Shot, Taken, or Killed in any part of the Colony until the same shall have been proclaimed as open for that purpose: Now, therefore, I, OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in exercise of the power and authority in me vested in that behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Districts of Suburbs of Nelson and Motueka, as constituted under the authority of "The Representation Act Amendment Act, 1871," of the General Assembly, shall be open for the purpose of Shooting Pheasants during the month of July next, by persons duly licensed under the above recited Act.
