PROTECTION is hereby Granted, under the provisions of the Goldfields Act, 1866, to F. VIOLICH and G. PAILELICH, for the term of Three years from the date hereof, for a Punt Ferry across the Grey River, at the junction of the Little Grey, subject to the following conditions, viz.—

1. That a substantial Punt shall be placed on the River at the site named, within two months from this date, and maintained in good working order during the term of protection.
 2. That a competent ferryman shall be always in attendance, and the ferry shall be at all times conducted to the satisfaction of the Warden of the district.
 3. The Warden of the district may, on being satisfied that the ferry is not conducted in an efficient manner, and in accordance with these conditions, suspend the operation of this protection until the matter of complaint be removed; and if the matter of complaint be not removed within a reasonable time, the Superintendent shall have the power to cancel this protection.
 4. The tolls to be charged for the use of the punt shall not exceed the following, viz.—

5. This protection shall extend along the river for a distance of two miles, that is to say one mile each side of the site of the punt.
 6. This protection shall not have any effect or operation until the punt has been placed on the river in good working order, to the satisfaction of the Provincial Engineer.
 7. All Regulations which may at any time be brought into force under section 13 of "The Goldfields Act, 1866, shall be deemed applicable to this protection as if it had been granted under the same.
 8. This protection shall not be transferred without the sanction of the Superintendent.
