#### ALTERATION OF ROADS.

**T**HE Undersigned give notice that they intend to apply to two or more Justices of the Peace, at a sitting to be held on Wednesday the 30th day of July, 1873, at the Court-house, Nelson, for an order for stopping up the undermentioned roads, and for making others in lieu thereof; and further, that we have caused survey plans of the several lines of roads proposed to be stopped up, substituted, and made, together with the books of reference and estimates to be deposited with the Clerk to the Magistrates, at Nelson, and with the Constable of the district of Suburban North:—
