**B**ENJAMIN GOUGH is hereby authorised, under the provisions of section XIII of "The Goldfields Act, 1866," to place upon the river Ahaura, opposite the Ahaura island, near the township of Ahaura, a self-acting Punt, travelling upon a wire rope across the river; and he is protected in the sole right of ferrying on the said river within one mile of the said island for three years from this date, and authorised to charge tolls as per schedule, on the following conditions:—

1. That a good safe boat and a competent ferryman shall be at all times in attendance at the Ahaura Ferry, and the punt be kept in good working order.

1. That all Government officers on duty, including Postmen and Road Overseers, be ferried free of charge.

3. That this protection shall not prejudice the right of the Government to erect a bridge, or to grant protection for the erection of a bridge over the Ahaura river within the protected limits.

4. That this protection shall not be transferred without the sanction of the Superintendent.
