THE following regulations, applying to persons in occupation of Accommodation Reserves, are published, by direction of the Superintendent, for general information :—

1. Every occupier of an Accommodation Reserve shall provide suitable accommodation and good food for travellers, and shall also supply horse feed of fair quality, by weight, at a reasonable price per pound.
2. Every occupier of any such reserve shall keep a book at his accommodation-house, which shall be placed at the disposal of travellers who may desire to enter therein any complaints or remarks with reference to the food or lodging with which they have been provided at such accommodation-house.
3. Such book shall be kept unmutilated and in good order and preservation, and shall be subject to periodical inspection by a member of the police force, or some other duly authorised person.
4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1876, and shall remain in force until revoked or amended.
