PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Colony of New Zealand, &c., &c.

WHEREAS, by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, intituled "The Nelson Special Settlement Act, 1872," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, with the advice of his Executive Council, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette of the said Province, to set aside out of the Waste Lands of the Crown, within the said Province, any block or blocks of land for the purpose of a Special Settlement: Now, therefore, I, OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, with the advice of my Executive Council, hereby proclaim and set aside for the purpose of special settlement the block of land hereinafter described, viz. :—
