PROCLAMATION.

By his Honor JOHN WALLIS BARNICOAT, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, in the Colony of New Zealand, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by "The Protection of Animals Act, 1873," it is provided that no game shall be hunted, shot, taken, or killed in any Province until the same shall have been proclaimed as open for that purpose: And whereas a proclamation was issued by OSWALD CURTIS, Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, dated the 8th day of May, 1876, declaring that Pheasants and Quail may be shot from the 15th day of May till the 30th day of June then next, within certain limits described in the said Proclamation, by persons duly licensed under the above recited Act: And whereas it is desirable to extend the time within which Quail may be shot, within the limits so described:

Now, therefore I, JOHN WALLIS BARNICOAT, Deputy-Superintendent of the Province of Nelson, do hereby proclaim and declare that Quail may be shot within the boundaries described in the Proclamation aforesaid, dated the 8th day of May, 1876, until the 30th July next inclusive.
