No. 3.—North of Courtenay street and East of Liardet street.
No. 4.—South of Courtenay street and East of Carrington Road.

CONDITIONS :

- 1.—The districts will be put up separately, and will be sold to the highest bidder, and if any dispute shall arise as to the bidding for any district the same will be put up again.
2.—No person shall at any bidding ad-

vance less than one pound or retract his bidding.

3.—The purchase money will be payable as follows:—Ten per cent. at the close of the auction, and the remainder by four equal instalments payable on the first days of January, April, July, and October, 1858, respectively.
