**PROCLAMATION.**

By His Excellency Colonel THOMAS GORE BROWNE, Companion of the most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Her Majesty's Colony of New Zealand, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c.

**W**HEREAS by the Ordinance for establishing a Supreme Court, Session 3, No. 1, it is provided that there shall be holden Circuit Courts for the despatch of Civil and Criminal business of the Court before one of the Judges thereof, at such places and at such times, as the Governor shall with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation, from time to time appoint.

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and appoint that a Circuit Court shall be holden before

The Hon. GEORGE ALFRED ARNEY,

Chief Justice of the said Court,

at the Town of New Plymouth, on the twenty seventh day of September, inst., or so soon after the said day as conveniently may be.

Sir,—I have the honor to inform you that in consequence of the necessity of making provision during the current year for Military Services, the General Government has been compelled to relinquish for the present its intention of increasing the rate of the advances to the Provinces on account of the surplus Revenues of the year ending 30th June, 1859.

These advances will therefore for the present be continued at the same rate as

during the past financial year, namely three-eighths of the gross Customs receipts in the several Provinces.
