PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington.

I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, *do hereby PROCLAIM, DECLARE, and DIRECT*, that a *Board of Commissioners* shall be established for the Management of the Streets, the Sewerage, and Drainage, and the Preservation of the Health of the Inhabitants of that portion of the Town of Wellington comprised within the following boundaries, viz.:

- North Harbour Section, No. 1.
- North East and East, the Harbour.
- North West and South, the Reserve known as the Town Belt.
- And South East, Sydney Street and Glenbervie Terrace, including such Streets.

And I, the Superintendent aforesaid, by and with the advice of my Executive Council, *do further PROCLAIM and DECLARE*, that the Board for the purposes aforesaid shall consist of nine Commissioners.
