£1000 *Reward.*

AVAILABLE GOLD FIELD.

Wellington, 15th January, 1862.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Provincial Government of Wellington, will award a Sum or Sums of Money, not exceeding the whole the amount of One Thousand Pounds Sterling, payable to any one person, or distributable rateably amongst any number of persons, who shall discover and make known to the Government the existence of an available Gold Field within the Province of Wellington.

All claims for the payment of this Reward, or any portion of it, are to be sent in to the Government, addressed to the Provincial Secretary in the first instance, by whom they will be afterwards referred to the decision of a Commission consisting of three persons, one to be named by the Wellington Chamber of Commerce and two by the Superintendent.

By "Available Gold Field" is meant a district within which Gold shall be judged by the Commissioners to exist capable of affording employment to a body of not less than six hundred (600) diggers at a remunerative rate of wages.

STRIPED—That there is a passage on either side.

Proclamation.

UNDER DISEASED CATTLE ACT, 1861.

WHEREAS by the Diseased Cattle Act, 1861, it was provided that the Governor in Council might by warrant under his hand from time to time delegate to the Superintendent of any Province within the said colony, all or any of the powers vested in the Governor, or Governor in Council, by the said act, subject to such Regulations as he might think fit, and might from time to time rescind such delegation. And whereas the said Governor hath, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of New

Zealand, delegated to Thomas Carter, Esq., so long as he shall hold the office of Superintendent of the Province of Marlborough, the several powers vested in the said Governor by the second, fourth, fifth, seventh, ninth, and tenth sections of the said act, subject to being rescinded as in the said act provided, and subject to the Regulations issued by the Governor in Council, on the fifteenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty three, and to any other Regulations to be from time to time duly made. And whereas it has been made to appear to me as such Superintendent as aforesaid that the disease called "Pleuro-pneumonia," being an infectious or contagious disease, has broken out amongst cattle within the several districts hereinafter described.

Now, therefore, I, Thomas Carter, by virtue of such powers in me vested, do hereby proclaim and declare that the districts comprising the several Provinces of Otago and Southland, in the Middle Island, and the districts comprising the several Provinces of Auckland, Wellington, Hawke's Bay, and Taranaki, in the North Island, are infected within the meaning of the said act, and that from and after Manday, the 18th day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four no cattle shall be imported from the said districts into the Province of Marlborough.

Given under my hand, at Picton, this thirteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four.
