Proclamation.

By His Honor William Waring Taylor, Esquire, Deputy Superintendent of the Province of Wellington in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of the said Province of Wellington Session III No. 8 intituled "An Act to amend and consolidate the law relating to cattle trespass and impounding" it is enacted that the Superintendent of the said Province may from time to time by proclamation declare any pounds to be or cease to be public pounds within the meaning of the said Act and may in like manner appoint suspend remove and re-appoint keepers of such pounds Now therefore I William Waring Taylor Deputy Superintendent of the said Province do hereby proclaim and declare the stockyard of Francis Fisk Horokiwi Road District in the Province of Wellington aforesaid to be a public pound within the meaning of the said Act and that Francis Fisk be the keeper thereof.
